DETAILED REASON FOR ARBITRATION

BVAA DOES NOT ARBITRATE FOR:

FORD 5.4L ENGINES / NISSAN 2.5L ENGINES / COLD START UP ENGINE NOISE / CVT TRANSMISSIONS.
HOWEVER, BVAA DOES RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ARBITRATE THESE UNITS IN CASES TO BE EXCESSIVE,
INOPERABLE, OR UNSAFE

- Dealers understand that this sale remains a good sale and payment is required until the auction determines the outcome of arbitration.
- Dealers will be contacted within 24 to 48 hours of written notice of arbitration.
- Yellow light arbitration form must be received before 5 pm on sale day
- Unit must be returned to auction within 2 days, if local buyer, and 3 days, if out of town. Failure to do so will make arbitration invalid.
- Arbitrations found not to be valid will be charged \$95
- Vehicles with more than 200 miles per month from the time sold are not eligible for arbitrations.
- If the Buyer chooses to have BVAA make any repairs to the vehicle, REPAIRS MUST BE PAID FOR BEFORE THE VEHICLE WILL BE RELEASED.
- Title arbitrations-The seller has until the end of the next business day from the time arbitrated to produce the title (If arbitration is after 4 pm, the Seller has until 5 pm of the 2nd business day).

IN THE CASE OF A RETURNED PSI, BVAA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO HAVE THE UNIT REPAIRED IN ORDER TO KEEP THE SALE VALID. This decision is at the auction's discretion and not the buyers.

- BVAA shop rate is \$50/per hr.
- BVAA has the right to use new or used parts at our discretion.
- BVAA is not responsible for parts that are on backorder or unavailable, which cause delays in repairs.
